

Your Rotary Club of Okotoks is made up of a group of a very active friends and neighbors whose projects, for the last 32 years, have made significant positive impacts on the lives of Okotoks and area residents. For the most part, children and youths have been our major beneficiaries. This year, understandably, we have focussed our efforts on projects which positively impact, either directly or indirectly, area residents affected by Covid-19.

Three major projects have already helped. First, we supported local youth Owen Plumb (who won the premier's first Northern Lights Award) in his efforts to build PPE for healthcare workers. Second, partnering with the Western Wheel and the Dawgs baseball club, we initiated the Drive for 5 campaign in May, raising over \$50,000 and 5000+ lbs of food for our local food bank. And third, with the support of local dental offices, we packed 100 care kits for the moms and kids who require the services of Rowan House emergency Shelter.

We are please to share with you, our latest initiative. **Revved-UP Rotary Roundup**, a scavenger Hunt /car Rally to raise funds to help local schools purchase PPE and other Covid-19 supplies for re-opening. Our Goal is to raise \$10,000+ to be divided between the two local school divisions: Foothills School Division and Chris Redeemer School Division.

Your Rotary Club of Okotoks strength is in partnering with local businesses to host a safe, fun event while raising funds for important community initiatives, just as we have done for over 30 years in hosting the annual Okotoks Rotary SoapBox Derby!
