

BYLAW 10-22 - COMMITTEES BYLAW 13-21 AMENDMENT

Purpose

The purpose of Bylaw 10-22 is to amend Committees Bylaw 13-21 to authorize the Governance and Priorities Committee to make naming decisions under the Naming Roadways, Parks, Neighbourhoods and Facilities Policy GP-B-2.4.

Readings

This bylaw is ready for three readings.

Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

At the March 2022 Governance and Priorities Committee (GPC) the following resolution was passed:

"That a recommendation be forwarded to Council to approve amendments to Policy GP-B-2.4 to include:

- a. formal process for naming roadways, parks, neighbourhoods, and facilities with Indigenous names;
- b. definitions for "historical significance", "geographical location", "honoured citizen", and "sponsor";
- c. improved wording with regard to sponsorship;
- d. removal of subsection 2.2:
- e. other amendments as recommended by the Governance and Priorities Committee at the March 21, 2022 meeting; and

That the authority for approving naming and renaming of roadways, parks, neighbourhoods, and facilities be delegated to the Governance and Priorities Committee."

As recommended by the GPC, a draft amending bylaw is provided for Council consideration with the delegated authority for naming noted in red as a new provision of Schedule 5 of Committee Bylaw 13-21. The proposed changes to the policy will be brought forward once the delegation is approved.
