



FIRE SERVICES MEDICAL RESPONSES MONTHLY UPDATE

Issue

A review of emergency medical services' response times in Okotoks is provided monthly for Council's information.

Motion Proposed by Administration

That the Fire Services Medical Responses Monthly Update for November 2023 be received as information.

Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

In November 2023, Okotoks Fire & Rescue (OFR) responded to 69 medical calls, 37 of which OFR arrived on scene prior to emergency medical services. The total wait time of 4:01:39 is up significantly from our last reported high in July and is the highest of 2023.

November reported a total of 124 incidents, setting a new record for the year thus far. Among those, 69 (56%) were medical calls, up from 56 in October which was our previous record and giving a year to date of 46%.
