

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION – ELECTION SIGNAGE POLICY

Issue

Administration is requesting that the date contained in a motion made at the June 19, 2023 Governance and Priorities Committee meeting be amended.

Motion Proposed by Administration

That the date within the motion made at the June 19, 2023 Governance and Priorities Committee meeting regarding Election Signage Policy CMD P 3.9 be amended from the December 2023 Council meeting to the January 22, 2024 Council meeting.

Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

At the June 19, 2023 GPC meeting, the following motion was made:

That Election Signage Policy CMD-P-3.9 be brought back to the December 2023 Council meeting as a Bylaw.

Creating an Election Signage Bylaw requires an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw (LUB) to remove references to election signage, and in order to amend the LUB a public hearing must be held. First reading of the LUB amendment is scheduled for the January 22, 2024 Council meeting, and the public hearing is tentatively scheduled for February 26, 2024.

Administration would like to bring both bylaws forward together and therefore requests the date to bring back the Election Signage Policy as a bylaw be changed to January 22, 2023 for first reading, and second and third reading to the February 26 meeting to coordinate with the LUB changes.
