Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

At the annual Organizational Meeting, Council Members are appointed to both internal and external/regional committees, commissions, and boards.

The Municipal Government Act s. 174(d) states:

A councillor is disqualified from council if the councillor is absent from all regular council meetings held during any period of 8 consecutive weeks, starting with the date that the first meeting is missed, unless subsection (2) applies;"

Committees Bylaw 13-21 states that Committee Members cannot be absent for more than three (3) consecutive meetings; Council has extended this expectation to apply to any external boards, committees, or commissions, but recognizes that each governing body has the right to set its own attendance expectations to which appointed members must adhere.

The attendance report is made available to the public on the Town's website as prescribed by the Accountability and Transparency Policy.
