The 2022 Financial Indicator report was submitted to Council on November 20, 2023 and this report was received by the Town on December 7, 2023.

The report reflects comparisons for the City of Calgary to municipalities across Canada and the City of Calgary to other municipalities in the Calgary Region, mainly Airdrie, Cochrane and Okotoks.
