#### Schedule X – Mayor's Youth Council Committee (MYCC)

### **Purpose**

The MYCC is established to advise and collaborate with the Town on issues related to youth, community development, and the well-being of young residents within our municipality.

The MYCC aims to provide a platform for youth to voice their concerns, contribute to policy discussions, and initiate projects that enhance the quality of life for young people in our community.

## Membership

- Mayor
- Two (2) Council Representatives
- 21 Youth Members (between 14 to 21 years of age)

The Chair of the MYCC shall be a Council Representative or a Youth Member who is 18 years of age or older.

## Authority

Advise the Mayor and municipal government on matters concerning youth, community development, and related topics.

Identify and prioritize issues that affect young people within the community.

Initiate, develop, and lead projects and initiatives that address these identified issues including supports for youth mental health and well-being. Annually the MYCC will pick and focus on a self-selected topic and project.

Act as ambassadors for youth engagement and participation in civic matters.

Collaborate with local organizations, schools, and government departments to implement youth-focused initiatives.

Initiate Mayor for a Day Annual Program including facilitation of a Mayor for a Day video/essay contest. Applications must include ideas to implement to make Okotoks a better place to live. The chosen winner will work alongside the Mayor for a day and discuss their ideas with Council/Administration.

Provide information and advice regarding Town initiatives affecting youth including but not limited to:

- coordination of community events that profile youth issues;
- promotion of community engagement of youth in Okotoks community life and volunteerism; and
- receiving direction from Council on work or reports it requires on youth matters.

# **Accountability**

The Mayor or designate will oversee the Committee's activities and can make adjustments to the Committee's mandate or membership as necessary.

**Term** Ongoing

Meeting Frequency The MYCC meets a minimum of six (6) times per year.

**Funding** As authorized by Town Council in the Legislative & Policy Services Budget

during the annual budget cycle.
