

#### **BYLAW 08-24 - TRIBUNAL BOARDS**

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of Bylaw 08-24 is to establish Tribunal Boards in the Town of Okotoks (Town).

#### Readings

This Bylaw is ready for three readings.

#### **Report, Analysis and Financial Implications**

The Assessment Review Board (ARB) and Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB) are quasi-judicial boards as set out in the *Municipal Government Act (MGA)*. Although Council appoints members to these boards, they otherwise operate at an arms length from both Council and the Town.

It is a best practice to separate quasi-judicial boards from Council's governance boards to provide a clear distinction of their impartiality and other differences such as:

- Tribunal board members must complete provincial training every three (3) years;
- Council members are not appointed to tribunal boards;
- Tribunal board members are remunerated for their time;
- Fees are required when submitting an appeal;
- Authorization to enter into Intermunicipal agreements to use regional members. The
  Town is currently a member of an ARB pool administered by Airdrie. The Town is
  establishing a regional agreement for SDAB members to be administered by the Town that
  would be an addition to this bylaw and permitted under the MGA. It potentially may
  provide Town members the ability to use their training and serve a wider region.
