Installation of phase 3 of the wayfinding signs was to be completed during the week of March 11 to 15. However, the installation crew was called away before completing this phase. The crew returned and installed the remaining signs, including the one along 32nd Street for southbound travellers sometime during the week of March 18 to 22.

The VD1 #14 sign was installed after Councillor Lang identified it as missing. The VD1#14 sign is now installed on southbound 32nd Street and provides information for southbound travellers. For safety reasons the signs are not designed to be double-sided.
