

PROGRAM AND SERVICE REVIEW POLICY GP-E-2.1

Issue

The Program and Service Review Policy GP-E-2.1 is provided for Council's approval.

Motion Proposed by Administration

That the Program and Service Review Policy GP-E-2.1 be approved as recommended by the Governance and Priorities Committee.

Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

At the May 21, 2024 Governance and Priorities Committee (GPC) meeting, Members discussed draft Program and Service Review Policy GP-E-2.1.

Attached is Appendix A of the policy as of May 27, 2024. Appendix A will be continually developed throughout the year using the Municipal Reference Model (MRM). It is anticipated Appendix A will be complete with current external service and service levels by this fall. The MRM is a model used by municipalities across Canada to describe the government's services and to generate insights that help improve the provision of services. The MRM helps describe the business of government from the outside in using programs and services, and how these contribute to achieving defined outcomes. Focusing on outcomes, and how those outcomes are achieved through programs and services, provides insight to assess if the Town is doing the right things and if it is doing it effectively.

Appendix A contains the first phase of current services and service level inventory. This primarily represents the services provided by the Parks, Recreation, Operations, Waste, and Water business centres. Some services provided in these areas will be added throughout the schedule as some services are provided by more than one area.

The schedule for the development and presentation of the remaining external programs and services outlined in Appendix A is proposed as follows:
