

**BYLAW 6-01**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OKOTOKS  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF ASSESSOR  
OF THE TOWN OF OKOTOKS**

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994, Chapter M-26.1 came into force on January 1, 1995;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 210 of the Act allows a Council to pass a bylaw establishing a position to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer;

**AND WHEREAS** Council wishes to establish the position of assessor as a designated officer under Section 284(1) (d) of the Act;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Okotoks enacts as follows:

1. Council hereby establishes the position of Assessor for the Town of Okotoks as a designated officer.
2. Council may by resolution appoint or revoke the appointment of a person to the position of Assessor.
3. The Assessor shall be subject to the supervision of and be accountable to the Chief Administrative Officer.
4. Bylaw 15-98 is hereby repealed.
5. This bylaw comes into full force and effect upon the date of third and final reading.
