Event ideas

- Check which activities are already being organized in your community during the Welcoming Week period, so that they can easily be linked to this week.
- Local park clean-up or other community work
- A cooking demonstration with an newcomer chef
- A dance party with an newcomer DJ
- A film screening or book club featuring an newcomer filmmaker/author or film/book related to immigration
- A networking or training opportunity for entrepreneurs of diverse backgrounds
