Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

At the May 27, 2024 Council meeting Program and Service Review Policy GP-E-2.1 was approved with the first phase of Appendix A – Services and Service Level Inventory.

Attached is Appendix A of the Policy as of September 4, 2024, with the complete external services listed for the organization. This was developed using the Municipal Reference Model (MRM). The MRM is a model used by municipalities across Canada to describe the government's services and to generate insights that help improve the provision of services. The MRM helps describe the business of government from the outside in using programs and services, and how these contribute to achieving defined outcomes. Focusing on outcomes, and how those outcomes are achieved through programs and services, provides insight to assess if the Town is doing the right things and if it is doing it effectively.

Appendix A has been updated to include the current external services and service levels for Fire & Rescue, Community Engagement, Council, Strategic Leadership Team, Legislative Affairs, Customer Experience, Water Asset Management Services and Client Services across the organization. Also, the Affordable Housing Grant was added and the Below Market Housing Grant Removed.
