BYLAW 33-24

A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF OKOTOKS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW 17-21

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Part 17, Division 5 of the *Municipal Government Act (MGA)*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto the Council of the Town of Okotoks (Council) has adopted Land Use Bylaw 17-21 (Land Use Bylaw); and


WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to amend the Land Use Bylaw by amending the land use designation of certain lands within the Town of Okotoks; and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the *MGA*; and

WHEREAS Council has held a public hearing as required by Section 692 of the MGA.

NOW THEREFORE Council enacts that the Land Use Bylaw is amended as follows:

 Map 2.1 and Map 2.2 (Key Map 1), within Section 2.1 LAND USE MAPS, are amended by redesignating approximately 12.82 hectares (31.68 acres) of the NW-34-20-29-W4M from Agriculture and Land Holdings District (ALH) to Neighbourhood Core (NC) District, Traditional Neighbourhood (TN) District and Recreation & Open Space (ROS) District as shown on the sketch map below:



This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon third and final reading, and Bylaw 17-21 and any amendments thereto are hereby amended upon this Bylaw coming into effect.

READ A FIRST TIME this day of 2024.

READ A SECOND TIME this day of 2024.

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED this day of 2025.
