

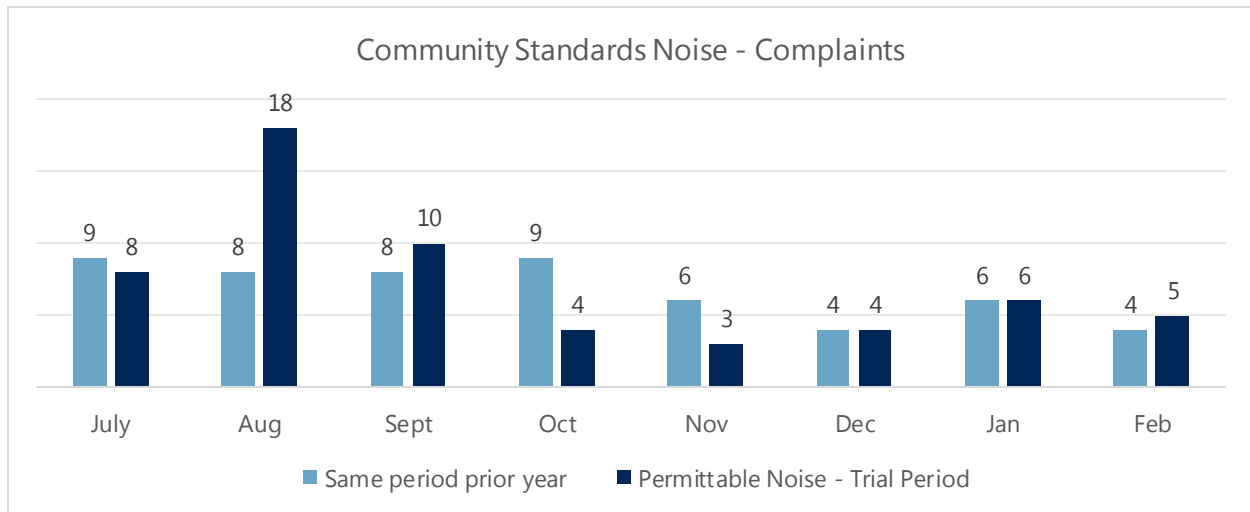
Permittable Hours of Noise Statistics

Data Effective Date: February 28th, 2026

Key Findings

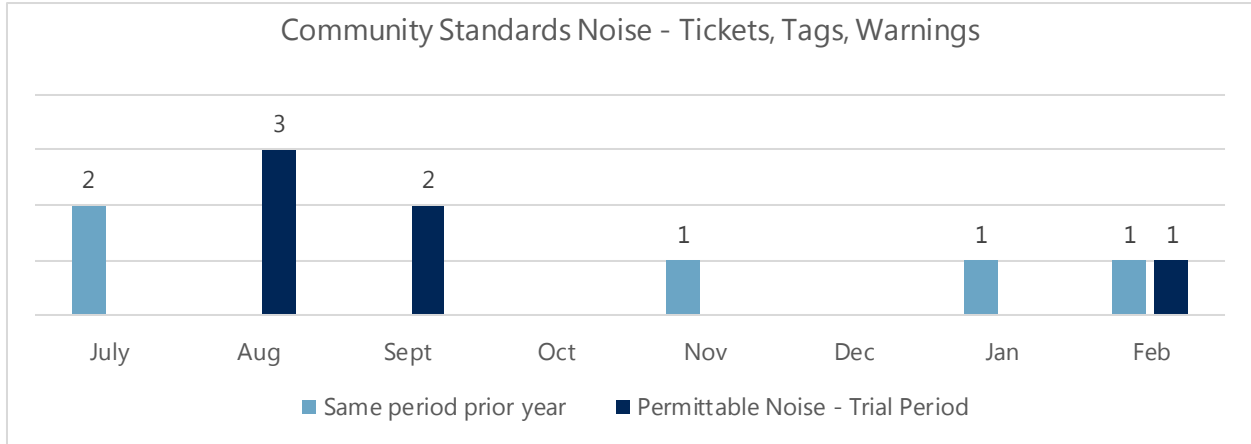
- Community Standards Bylaw 31-23 regulates noise and other community standards to protect resident well-being, including permitted noise hours and enforcement measures. In response to requests supporting seven-day-a-week commercial operations, Council approved a trial period adjusting permitted residential noise hours to 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m., seven days a week, effective July 1, 2025 to February 28, 2026.
- Noise-related complaints for the trial period (n=50) remained relatively consistent when comparing the same period the prior year, with a notable exception of higher volumes in August and September during the trial period.
- Current analysis shows no clear evidence linking the August/September increase in complaints to the change in permitted noise hours.
- Enforcement activity (tickets, tags, and warnings) through the trial period was 6, which is relatively consistent with the prior period (n=5), though ticketed violations during the trial period were primarily concentrated in August and September.
