### Issue

A request for donation has been received from the Ecole Okotoks Junior High School Ocelots Fundraising Society for an facility pass to the Okotoks Recreation Centre (ORC).

### Motion Proposed by Administration

That authorization for the donation of the Town's portion (\$159.16) of the cost of an annual facility adult pass to the Okotoks Recreation Centre for the Ecole Okotoks Junior High School Ocelots Fundraising Society be given. Source of Funds: Council Emergent / Public Relations.

### Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

The Town has received a letter from the Ecole Okotoks Junior High School Ocelots Fundraising Society requesting consideration for a donation of a recreation pass to the "A Family of Sweethearts" fundraising event benefitting technology and the arts at the school. The event will take place February 14, 2018.

The total value of the donation requested is \$578.77. The Town's portion of the facility pass is \$159.16 and Natural High Fitness's portion is \$419.61. Similar requests have previously been supported by Council in the past. Natural High Fitness has agreed to provide their portion of the facility pass for this request.
