Response

The Town of Okotoks currently has a contract with the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) for the provision of policing services within the town boundaries. The contract known as the Municipal Police Service Agreement (MPSA) expires in 2022.

As a municipality over 15,000 residents, the Town pays 90% of the cost of a member's rate with the balance of the cost, 10%, paid by the Federal Government.

- The 2017/18 100% rate for a regular member (RM) is \$166,000.
- 90% The 2017/18 90% rate for a RM is \$149,400
- Our current establishment is 25.5 members with the 0.5 being the School Resource Officer (SRO).
- Under the Municipal Police Assistance Grant Program (MPAG) the town receives \$100,000
 Premiers initiative and \$14.00 per capita based on the most recent federal census (28,881).
 The MPAG contribution reduces the 90% cost by approximately 13%.
